Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The annual camp for the Year 6 children will be held at Wainui YMCA Camp between **Wednesday 6th November and Friday 8th November, Term 4, Week 4.**

Attending camp and participating in the selected activities allows the children to

- Develop closer personal relationships
- Challenge themselves
- Work in a cooperative manner with others to reach a personal or group goal
- Take responsibility for their personal hygiene
- Take responsibility for their belongings

The activities the children may participate in are:

- Coast Steering, Kayaking, High Ropes, Archery, Challenge Event and Campfire.

The cost of the camp is **\$220 per child**. Transport to Wainui will be by parent transport which is a combination of camp parents, teachers and additional parent helpers.

To assist with payments, we are able to offer several options, which include monthly payments or payment in full. If you wish to discuss these options further, please talk to Kate Brunner and she will be able to assist. While payment to the office for camp can start at any time, we do ask that it is paid in full by Friday 10th November. We appreciate that this additional cost will have an impact on some families. If you are having difficulty making this payment please discuss this issue with our school principal..

To enable the camp to take place, we do require parental support. If you would like to register your interest in being a camp parent please read and complete the form below and return it to school by **Friday 5th July 2019**. As a parent helper we do require you to fully participate in the events with the children. They are tonnes of fun - I promise! There is no additional cost for parents who accompany us as parent helpers on camp. As we usually have a huge amount of parents wishing to join us, a ballot may be necessary to select our parent helps. We apologise in advance if we cannot accommodate everyone who expresses interest. Please also be aware that a Police Vet is required for all parents who are who are to accompany us on camp.
